The scholarship is an award for up to \$700.00 toward the cost of tools and will be awarded to two students in the Fall 2017 semester.

Eligibility Criteria:

- ✓ Be enrolled Full-Time in the NCC Automotive Technology Program
OR
Be enrolled Full-Time in the Honda Automotive Technology PACT Program and be active in the Autocross Club
(Full-Time enrollment is 12 or more credits)
- ✓ Be enrolled in senior level automotive courses during semester of scholarship
- ✓ Have a minimum CGPA of 2.5
- ✓ A valid driver's license and good driving record
- ✓ Demonstrate good moral character and leadership
- ✓ Demonstrate financial need as determined by completed FAFSA

Instructions:

- ✓ Complete the application on the back of the page (type or print in ink)
- ✓ Request a recommendation from a work supervisor, a faculty member outside of the Transportation Technology Department, or volunteer leader (recommendation form attached)
- ✓ If you are a Honda Automotive Technology PACT student, provide written confirmation from an Autocross Club Advisor that you are an active member.
- ✓ Provide a copy of your valid driver's license
- ✓ Provide a copy of your good driving record (see the NH Division of Motor Vehicles website to learn how to obtain a copy of your driving record at <http://www.nh.gov/safety/divisions/dmv/financial-responsibility/obtain-record.htm>)
- ✓ Submit the completed application, copy of your driver's license, copy of your driving record, and recommendation form by the deadline above to:
